Professor Pally teaches at New York University and Fordham University. Her most recent book is *Lob der Kritik. Warum die Demokratie nicht auf ihren Kern verzichten darf* (2003), before which she wrote two books on censorship and two on language



acquisition. She has written for *The New York Times*, *the Village Voice*, *Index on Censorship*, *die Zeit*, *Süddeutsche Zeitung*, *Cicero*, *Berliner Zeitung*, *Frankfurter Rundschau*, among other publications. She has lectured at numerous universities and institutes, among them the Aspen Institute, Berlin and the Evangelische Akademie Tutzing, Harvard, Columbia and The Cato Institute. Professor Pally is past president and founder of Feminists for Free Expression, past vice president of The Freedom to Read Foundation, and served on The Media and Communications Committee of the American Civil Liberties Union. An essay on the role of the EU in global affairs appears in the September issue of *Internationale Politik*.
